1. Approval of January meeting minutes
 - a. Motion to approve made by Damien; seconded by Mike
2. Treasurer's Report: current total is \$11,608.78. This is different from the end balance presented at the AGM (\$54 difference). We appear to be about \$140.16 short. The documents turned over by Tim C. only go back to December 2019. Damien is going to reach out to Tim C to get all the financial records. A rough break down of the total funds includes: \$2425.50 for the ladies and \$9183.28 for the men. There are 2 checks outstanding—check #898: AGL for banquet and check #901: No record. PayPal—Mike will reach out to Paul about getting this turned over to the club. Venmo needs a phone # and Damien is looking into Google Voice. Motion to approve Tim F., seconded by Mike

Ed is going to look into sites in Tonawanda also.
7. Meeting with Paul Mulcaire—Tabled (Mike spoke a little about this...Mike, Matt, Conor plan to talk about the youth board and Na Fianna).



8. Any Other Business: Sponsorship: Our club sponsorship with the AGL did end with the 2020 season, so we can begin looking elsewhere. We should look to get sponsors for multiple items such as one for uniforms, another for fields, and possibly pub quizzes. We will discuss this further at the next meeting.
